Cardiovascular

Antihypertensives (Blood Pressure):

ACE: Lisinopril (+/- HCTZ combo pill), Benazepril, Enalapril, Ramipril

ARB: Losartan (+/- HCTZ combo pill), Telmisartan, Olmesartan, Valsartan (+/- HCTZ)

CCB: Amlodipine, Diltiazem, Verapamil, Nifedipine

Diuretic: HCTZ, Triamterene/HCTZ, Furosemide, Torsemide, Spironolactone, Chlorthalidone

BB: Metoprolol (tartrate and succinate), Carvedilol, Atenolol, Propranolol (immediate/ER), Nadolol

Other: Clonidine, Hydralazine, Guanfacine, Minoxidil

Lipid Lowering (Cholesterol):

Atorvastatin, Pravastatin, Simvastatin, Rosuvastatin, Lovastatin, Fenofibrate 145mg or 160mg, Ezetimibe, Gemfibrozil

Antithrombotics (Blood Thinner):

Warfarin, Enoxaparin, ***Eliquis**, Prasugrel, Clopidogrel, Aspirin, ***Xarelto (uninsured only)**

Antiarrhythmics:

Amiodarone, Flecainide, Propafenone, Sotalol

Other:

Digoxin, Cilostazol, Nitroglycerin SL/Patch, Isosorbide, Ranolazine ER, ***Kerendia**

Asthma/COPD/Allergy

Albuterol rescue inhalers are available consistently for all patients. It is recommended that prescribers enroll uninsured patients in manufacturer assistance programs for maintenance inhalers when possible. For questions on inhaler availability, call 740-672-2095.

SABA (Rescue Inhaler):

Albuterol (200 puffs), see nebulizer solution

ICS:

QVAR RediHaler 40mcg (uninsured only, see nebulizer solution)

ICS+LABA:

Advair Diskus 100/50, 250/50 or 500/50, AirDuo RespiClick 55/14, 113/14, or 232/14

Nasal:

Fluticasone (Flonase) nasal spray, *QNASL 40mcg (uninsured only)*

Oral:

Montelukast, Prednisone, Diphenhydramine, Loratadine, Cetirizine, Fexofenadine, Cyproheptadine, *Theophylline ER 600mg (uninsured only)*

NOTE: We have spacers for inhalers – they do require a prescription. We also carry nebulizers. Please write a prescription for nebulizer device.

Nebulizer solutions available:

Albuterol 0.083%; Albuterol/Ipratropium (Duoneb), Ipratropium 0.02%, Budesonide 0.5mg/2ml, Levalbuterol 1.25mg/3ml

Diabetes

Injectable:

Novolin N, R, or 70/30 vials/pens, Tresiba pens (U-100/U-200), Insulin Glargine (generic Lantus Solostar) pens, **Ozempic*, & **Humalog U-100 vials/pens*, **Humulin U-500 pens*, Humalog vials/pens, Humalog mix vials/pens, Humulin N, R, or 70/30 vials, Basaglar, Trulicity (uninsured only)

**Other products may be available but supply will vary depending on donations. Call to check specific product availability.*

Oral:

Metformin immediate/ER, Glipizide immediate/XL, Glyburide, Glimepiride, Pioglitazone, Alogliptin, **Rybelsus*, Januvia, Janumet, Cinacalcet 90mg, **Jardiance 25mg (uninsured only)*

Neuropathy:

Amitriptyline, Nortriptyline, Cyanocobalamin (B12 tablets/injection), Duloxetine

Glucometer Kits and Supplies Available:

Strips per month: #25 (orals only), #50 (on insulin), #100 (sliding scale/adjusting insulin dose)

Mental Health

Antidepressants:

Citalopram, Escitalopram, Fluoxetine, Sertraline, Paroxetine, Venlafaxine immediate/ER, Duloxetine, Trazodone, Bupropion SR/XL, Amitriptyline, Nortriptyline, Mirtazapine, Doxepin

Anti-Anxiety:

Bupirone, Hydroxyzine, and SSRIs as above

Antipsychotics:

Risperidone, Haloperidol, Olanzapine regular/ODT, Quetiapine, Ziprasidone, Aripiprazole

Mood Stabilizers:

Lithium, Lamotrigine, Topiramate, Divalproex sodium DR/ER

ADHD:

Atomoxetine, Guanfacine ER

Substance Use Disorder:

Disulfiram, Naltrexone (oral), Narcan

Sleep:

Melatonin (and see Antidepressants)

Gastrointestinal/Urinary

GERD/Ulcer:

Famotidine, Pantoprazole, Omeprazole, Lansoprazole, Esomeprazole, Calcium Carbonate 500mg, Sucralfate

Nausea:

Meclizine, Promethazine, Ondansetron (regular/ODT), Prochlorperazine, Scopolamine Patches, *Emend (uninsured only)*

Constipation:

Polyethylene Glycol 3350, Docusate, Senna (+/- docusate), Lactulose, Bisacodyl, Fiber-Lax

Bowel Prep:

Gavilyte-C, Gavilyte-G, Gavilyte-N

Overactive Bladder:

Oxybutynin immediate/ER, Tolterodine immediate/ER

Prostate:

Tamsulosin, Doxazosin, Terazosin, Finasteride, Tadalafil

Other:

Dicyclomine, Metoclopramide, Hyoscyamine

Ulcerative Colitis:

Mesalamine ER 0.375gm, Mesalamine 1000mg Suppositories, Mesalamine 4gm/60ml Enema

Pain

Analgesics:

Acetaminophen, Ibuprofen, Naproxen, Meloxicam, Diclofenac (tablets/1% gel), Indomethacin, Celecoxib, Nabumetone, Lidocaine 4% Cream/Patch, *Lidocaine 5% Patch (uninsured only)*

Muscle Relaxants:

Cyclobenzaprine, Tizanidine, Methocarbamol, Baclofen

Neuropathic:

Amitriptyline, Nortriptyline, Duloxetine

Migraine:

Sumatriptan, Rizatriptan, Butalbital/APAP/Caffeine 50mg/325mg/40mg tablets

Steroids:

Prednisone, Methylprednisolone

DMARDS/Immunosuppressants:

Hydroxyurea, Methotrexate, Leflunomide, Sulfasalazine, Hydroxychloroquine, Tacrolimus, Mycophenolate Mofetil

Other:

Glucosamine Sulfate (+/- Chondroitin)

Infectious Disease

Antibiotics:

Amoxicillin (+/- Clav), Penicillin VK, Azithromycin, TMP/SMX, Cephalexin, Cefdinir, Cefadroxil, Cefuroxime, Clindamycin, Ciprofloxacin, Levofloxacin, Metronidazole, Mupirocin Ointment, Clarithromycin, Doxycycline, Minocycline, Nitrofurantoin, Vancomycin, Chlorhexidine rinse

Antitussive (Cough):

Benzonatate, Dextromethorphan syrup, Dextromethorphan/Guaifenesin syrup, Promethazine/Dextromethorphan syrup, Guaifenesin tablets/syrup

Antiviral:

Acyclovir, Valacyclovir, Famciclovir

Antifungals:

Oral: Fluconazole, Terbinafine

Topical: Miconazole (including Vaginal 3 or 7 Day), Clotrimazole (+/- betamethasone), Terbinafine, Nystatin, Ketoconazole (Cream or Shampoo)

Miscellaneous

Thyroid:

Levothyroxine, Methimazole, Liothyronine, NP Thyroid

Phosphate Binder:

Calcium Acetate

Alzheimer's:

Donepezil, Memantine

Dopamine agonists:

Carbidopa/Levodopa, Ropinirole, Pramipexole

Osteoporosis:

Alendronate 35mg & 70mg, Risedronate 150mg

Gout:

Allopurinol, Colchicine Tablets

Topical Corticosteroids:

Triamcinolone Cream or Ointment, Clobetasol, Hydrocortisone Cream, Fluocinonide Cream, Fluticasone Cream, Mometasone Cream

Anticholinergic: Benztropine

HIV: Atripla, [Isentress \(uninsured only\)](#)

Scabies: Permethrin

Hormonal

Medroxyprogesterone, Progesterone, Estradiol (Tablets, 0.01% Vaginal Cream, ***Patches**), Letrozole, Anastrozole, Tamoxifen, Norethindrone, Ethinyl Estradiol/Norgestimate 0.035mg/0.25mg, Ethinyl Estradiol/Norethindrone/Ferrous Fumarate 0.02mg/1mg/75mg or 0.03mg/1.5mg/75mg

Anti-Epileptics (Anti-Seizure)

Divalproex DR/ER, Levetiracetam, Topiramate, Phenytoin, Oxcarbazepine, Zonisamide, Lamotrigine, Carbamazepine

Smoking Cessation

Bupropion SR, Nicotine Gum/Lozenge/Patch

Vitamins/Nutritional Health

Calcitriol, Calcium Carb + D, Ferrous Sulfate, Folic Acid, Potassium Cl, Magnesium Oxide, Prenatal Vitamins, Vitamin D 50,000 units

Eye Care

Glaucoma:

Brimonidine 0.2%, Dorzolamide/Timolol, Dorzolamide, Latanoprost, Timolol 0.5%

Anti-infective:

Ciprofloxacin, Ofloxacin 0.3%, Gentamicin 0.3%, Tobramycin 0.3% (solution), Neomycin/Polymyxin B/Dexamethasone Ointment/Suspension (*may be used otic if appropriate*)

Steroid:

Prednisolone 1% solution

NSAID:

Ketorolac 0.5% solution

Allergies:

Ketotifen

Other:

Cromolyn, Refresh Plus
