

WE'RE EXPANDING! IN A GOOD WAY

We're excited that we'll soon have a larger more convenient office from which to serve our patients. One of the best things about this expansion is that we didn't have to move to make it happen! By joining our current office with one right next door we are able to double our area and create a more efficient clinic. A definite benefit that will come from this change is having our dental clinic in the same office with the medical clinic. Since opening in 2013, Hope Clinic Dental has occupied an office in the same building but separated from the medical clinic. "After receiving a voucher for a free eve examination and glasses, a patient called to let us know the local eye doctor found he has cataracts beginning in both eyes. He then went on to say how much Hope Clinic had impacted his life. He has lost weight, feels 50 rather than 80 and couldn't be more thankful for the help he has received here, including his new glasses!"

"In a routine diabetic appointment for one patient, the provider ordered lab work and an ultrasound on the Thyroid because he felt it was enlarged. The ultrasound found the thyroid had multiple nodules and his thyroid labs were abnormal. With this information and a consultation with another Endocrinologist, the patient was referred to an ENT. The patient had surgery to remove the thyroid and the findings were negative for cancer. The patient's labs are now normal and medication is helping him maintain his condition. He is thankful we discovered the problem and were able to help him get things taken care of."

"My mom has to have urea daily to keep her sodium levels up. Her urea was not covered by her insurance and she couldn't survive without it. Hope clinic pharmacy was able to obtain the urea for her daily use."



"A husband and wife came to the clinic because they lost their insurance and could not afford insurance premiums. They were both diabetic and had numbers that were out of range. They were able to obtain free labs and medication and get appointments with an endocrinology specialist. The husband was able to get free insulin medication that would normally cost \$500 per month. His A1c (average blood sugar) is now improved and overall, both of their medical conditions are better due to the care and services provided at Hope Clinic."

"My insurance denied covering some of my medications but Hope Clinic was able to provide them. If they had not, I would not be able to take them."
